How can I adjust my ISP?

You want to take fewer subjects because your study program is too heavy. Something unexpected has happened and you can't make it to all of your lessons, ...

Students with a status can request **an adjustment in their ISP** via their <u>pathway supervisor</u>, as a facility. You can have yourself **deregistered for 1 or more subjects, so that your study package is more feasible or more compatible with your situation**.

Note that you need to take **at least 27 credits**, to be recognised as a 'student'. Getting your ISP amended cannot be done throughout the year. **A first deadline is 30 October 2024** for changing first semester and year subjects. **The second deadline is 12 March 2025** for changing second-semester subjects.

Since academic year 2023-2024, the "study progress milestone system" has been in place. Among other things, this new legislation has an impact on compiling your ISP and taking credits.

Have you reached the milestone and passed your first 60 credits? Then you can immediately contact your learning path counsellor to adjust your ISP. Please note that this is only possible within certain deadlines.

If you have not yet achieved the milestone:

As a student with special status, you can adjust your study program, as an accommodation:

- Has your status been approved? Then contact your learning path counsellor directly to adjust your ISP. Note: this is only possible within certain deadlines.
- Don't have a status yet but think you qualify for one? Go to KULoket to apply for your status.
